Race office will be opened on Friday January 11 from 4pm to 6pm EST. Office is located in the Chalet Excellence Acrobatique in front of the free style stadium. Registration will be officially closed at 6:00pm EST.</p> <hr/> <p>Entry Deadline: Wednesday January 9, 2019 at 19:00 EST (ICR 604.4.1)</p> <hr/> <p>Accepted payment methods: cash, travelers' checks and money order drawn in Canadian funds and VISA credit card. Team checks must be issued to "Club de Compétition Val Saint-Côme" PERSONAL CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED. Coaches are required to pay for their whole team.</p>		
BIB DEPOSIT FEE	\$100 per team, <u>Check only</u> . Checks will be destroyed or returned upon return of all bibs after the race. No refund will be given to teams whose medalist athlete doesn't show up at the award ceremony.
