Registration Fees

50\$ per race – includes lift ticket and taxes, cheque payable to: **Club de Ski Owl's Head**) or in cash on **Friday, January 11th between 5pm-7pm at the CSOH Club Room (Main Chalet)**. Personal checks will be refused. Registration list will be officially closed at 7pm.

All coaches and athletes are required to sign the coaches and athletes protocol (circuit CJP). The signed protocols must be handed in during the registration period. The documents can be found online on the SQA website in the Race Notice section of the Owl's Head ENL race.

Entry deadline: Two (2) weeks prior to the first race day for Quebec athletes, and Wednesday, January 9th 2019 at 11:59pm EST (RIS 604.4.1) for out of province athletes.





Race Bibs	Each team will be required to leave a 100\$ deposit (cash or club cheque) for the race bibs on Friday night, in accordance with the rules. Cheques will be returned Sunday if all the race bibs are collected.								
Training	Training run will be available on Friday, January 11th. Reduced price lift tickets will be available at the ticket counter but only upon presentation of I.D. There will be an attendance list.								
Protests	All protests and appeals must be submitted in writing according to FIS rules to the race secretary office. Protest fee is \$100 CAD cash deposit (RIS 644.4)
